Description of the BIP:

The "Blended Intensive Program on Human-centric Ethics, AI and Responsible Transformation" (HEART) offers a comprehensive exploration of responsible digital transformation through a combination of remote lectures and stationary practicals.

The program covers diverse topics to provide participants with a well-rounded, **interdisciplinary understanding** of human-centric Ethics, AI, and Responsible Transformation.

The course bridges the **technical implementation** of computer science (such as Explainable AI, data bias mitigation, and Privacy by Design) with **the humanitarian, social, and media perspectives of public communications** (covering AI governance, digital ethics, accessibility, and visual literacy).

Participants will engage in a virtual onboarding phase, face-to-face lectures, hands-on workshops, risk auditing, and collaborative projects, culminating in practical tasks like auditing AI decision-making engines and creating transparency frameworks.

Forms of activities:

- ✓ **Online lectures** - 0.5 ECTS (10 hours)
- ✓ **Face to face Module** - 1.5 ECTS (lectures, workshops and study visits) (25 hours)
- ✓ **Students' own work** - 1 ECTS (15 hours)
