I am currently working as an associate professor at Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University. I completed my BA in Mimar Sinan University in 2000 and my MA in 2003 in Architectural Conservation Programme of Yildiz Technical University (Turkey) with the master thesis entitled "Proposals for the Conservation of Arapoglu Mansion in Beyoglu and Ahududu street on which the building stands". In 2012, I earned my PhD at Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University, in Architectural Conservation. Part of my dissertation entitled "An Investigation on the Conservation and Restoration Processes of Monumental Buildings in Istanbul During the Republican Era" was awarded by the Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University Scientific Research Project Fund. My research primarily focuses on the theory and history of architectural conservation in the world and particularly in Turkey, before and after the foundation of the Republic in 1923. Through my research, I intend to contribute to knowledge by identifying the complexities of conservation of cultural assets in a country like Turkey, where most of the the principles have not originated out of its own culture, but been imported from different European countries (mainly France) in the late 19th century. I also make archive based research on some of the eminent Turkish conservation architects that lived in 20th century and discover their relations with international conservation theory and principles of their time. My academic interests include the theories developed on the issues around authenticity, and reconstructions of totally demolished historic buildings and the reasons that lie behind these practices.
