The Vocational School aims at educating students as qualified individuals possessing knowledge and skills sectors require. The practice courses are given at Maltepe University School of Medicine Hospital, schools, Five-Star Marma Hotel within the same campus, Istanbul Asia Film Studios, Airplane Cabin Simulator, Airplane Technology Lab and Fashion Design Studio.

The Vocational School has 17 programs four of which are accredited. Civil Aviation Transportation Management, Civil Aviation Cabin Services, Aircraft Technology have been accredited by Civil Aviation General Directorate (SGHM), Tourism and Hotel Management has been accredited by Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Tourism Education (TURAK).

The School of Nursing

The curriculum includes basic nursing courses as well as basic medicine and social sciences. Electives like music, acting, visual and verbal communication skills support development of students' empathic skills, understanding and perception. Clinical practices are done at Maltepe University Faculty of Medicine Hospital and various hospitals in İstanbul.

Marmara Education Village was founded in 2002 in order to assemble all the Marmara Education Institutions led by İMEV in 1000 acres of open land and 300 acres of closed spaces among the pine trees. The campus houses the Faculty of Education, Faculty of Fine Arts, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Communication, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Business and Management Sciences, Faculty of Architecture and Design, Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, Conservatory, School of Nursing, Vocational School, School of Foreign Languages and Institute of Graduate Studies.

The campus also includes a 10,000-seat Maltepe Grand Amphitheater and a 4,000 square meter film and television plateau.

What else do we have?

The campus also hosts to a library, dining halls, cafes, restaurants, recreation areas, theatres, open-air cinema, studios, TV studios, laundry, multi-purpose gymnasium, swimming pool in Olympic size, football pitches, basketball courts, volleyball courts, tennis courts, trekking areas, infirmary, hair-dresser's, copy centre, market, exhibition spaces, and a commercial bank.

The dorms provide accommodation in the comfort of home where all the needs of students are taken care.
